BYLAW NO. 02/2024

A BYLAW TO LICENSE THE EXCAVATION OF GRAVEL FROM GRAVEL PITS

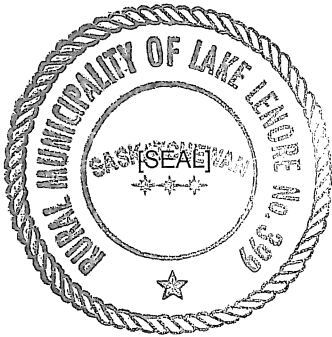
The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lake Lenore #399 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the "*Gravel Licensing Bylaw*".
2. In this bylaw:
  - a. "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
  - b. "Contractor" includes any person, firm, or corporation, including those persons, firms, or corporations engaged by the crown but does not include the crown;
  - c. "Council" shall mean the elected council of the municipality;
  - d. "Gravel" includes rock, stone, sand, and other material in excess of 105 microns (0.004 inches) in diameter;
  - e. "Discharge" includes to ignite, fire, or set off, and the words "discharging" and "discharged" have similar meaning;
  - f. "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Lake Lenore No. 399;
  - g. "Premises" includes any pit, site or location within the municipality in which gravel is naturally situated and from which gravel may be or is being extracted.
3. No contractor shall operate or offer for hire any machine, tractor, truck, or other appliance used in excavation of gravel from any premises within the municipality without having first obtained a license to do so from the municipality.
4. Any contractor requiring a license under provision of this bylaw shall each year make written application, using the form shown in Schedule "A" attached hereto forming part of this bylaw, to the administrator, and pay a gravel extraction license fee of:
  - a. \$0.194 per cubic meter for each cubic meter of gravel; or
  - b. \$0.148 per cubic yard for each cubic yard of gravel; or
  - c. \$0.104 per cubic tonne for each cubic tonne of gravel; or
  - d. \$0.097 per ton for each ton of gravelexcavated from the premises in the permit year.
5. Subject to the right of Council to suspend or revoke the same as provided by *The Municipalities Act*, every license shall remain in force or in effect until and including the 31 day of December of the year of issue.
6. On or before January 15 of the year following the permit year, the contractor shall make a return under oath, in the form shown in Schedule "B" attached hereto forming part of this bylaw, to the administrator showing the quantity of gravel excavated from each premises and pay the prescribed fee as set out in Section 4 of this bylaw.

7. The municipality shall refund to the contractor any fees collected under this bylaw for estimated quantities of gravel not extracted from the premises and for which the license fee has been paid.
8. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in subsections 381(3) of *The Municipalities Act*.
9. Bylaw #01/2022 is hereby repealed.
10. This bylaw shall come into force on the 10 day of January, 2024.
