

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LAKE LENORE NO. 399 TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE KERMARIA CHURCH OF ST. BRIEUX, SASKATCHEWAN AS BEING A SITE OF HISTORICAL VALUE.

WHEREAS part III of the Heritage Property Act authorizes the council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural, historical or natural value of interest, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Rural Municipality of Lake Lenore No. 399 has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as the Kermaria Church at North West Section 20-41-19- West of the Second a notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in at least two issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least twenty-one(21) days prior to the date of consideration of the bylaw and with the last publication at least seven(7) days prior to the date of that consideration, and

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the administrator of the municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Rural Municipality of Lake Lenore No. 399 enacts as follows:

- 1. There is designated as being of historical value or interest the real property known as Kermaria Church at the North West 20-41-19 West of the Second and legally described as follows:

The West Half of the West Half of Legal Subdivision Four(4) of Section Twenty(20), in Township Forty-one(41), in Range Nineteen(19), West of the Second Meridian, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada, containing Ten(10) acres, more or less. Excepting: Fifty-two Hundredths(0.52) of an acre, more or less, taken for a Roadway as shown on Plan No. AA 1823.

MINERALS IN THE CROWN


The significance of the site is as follows:

- a. The building is a landmark in the community.
- 2. The R.M. administrator is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Titles Office.
- 3. The R.M. administrator is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister and to cause notice of the passing of the this bylaw.
- 4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
