BYLAW NO. 6/2014

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LAKE LENORE #399 TO PROVIDE FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE CHARGES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lake Lenore #399 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw:
 - a. "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b. "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c. "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Lake Lenore #399.
- 2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services provided by the St. Brieux and District Fire Protection Association shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached to and forming a part of this bylaw.
- 3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year.
