

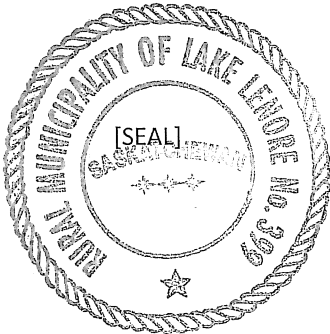


A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LAKE LENORE NO. 399 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT FOR THE WILLOW POINT SUBDIVISION

The Council for the Rural Municipality of Lake Lenore No. 399 in the Province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Willow Point Speed Limit Bylaw".
2. In this Bylaw:
 - a. "motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined by or pursuant to *The Traffic Safety Act*;
 - b. "municipal road" means a road used by the general public for the passage of vehicles and does not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to the provisions of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*;
 - c. "speed zone" means any portion of a municipal road within the Rural Municipality of Lake Lenore No. 399 as designated herein and identified by a sign erected and maintained at each end thereof indicating the maximum speed applicable thereto.
3. That maximum speed of thirty (30) kilometres per hour be established for all motor vehicles within the boundaries of the Willow Point Subdivision located in the Rural Municipality of Lake Lenore No. 399.
4. Any person found guilty of the violation of the speed set out in Section 3 of this Bylaw, shall, upon summary conviction, be subject to the penalties set out in *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997* and the regulations thereto as they relate to those travelling within a speed zone at a greater than which is permitted.
5. This bylaw shall come into effect upon the third reading.
