

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LAKE LENORE NO. 399

BYLAW NO. 1-1998

A Bylaw to provide for entering into an agreement respecting the formation of a Mutual Aid Area Emergency Measures Organization.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lake Lenore No. 399, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The R.M. of Lake Lenore NO. 399 is hereby authorized to enter into the agreements, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, and identified as Exhibit A and Exhibit B, with the following municipalities;

Village of St. Brieux

R.M. of Flett's Springs No. 429

R.M. of Three Lakes No. 400

for the purpose stated within the agreements.

2. The Reeve and Administrator of the Rural Municipality of Lake Lenore No. 399 are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached agreements identified as Exhibit A and Exhibit B.

EXHIBIT "A"

THIS AGREEMENT MADE AMONG

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LAKE LENORE NO. 399

AND

THE VILLAGE OF ST. BRIEUX

AND

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF FLETT'S SPRINGS NO. 429

WHEREAS the municipalities above mentioned deem it expedient to enter into an agreement for the purpose of exercising the powers conferred upon them by Section 9 of the Civil Defence Act, and outlining a general plan dealing with matters of civil emergency within the said municipalities,

AND WHEREAS the parties to this agreement intend to establish an organization of the type contemplated in Section 9 of the Civil Defence Act:

NOW THEREFORE THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. The parties hereto agree to joint action for civil emergency planning through formation of a mutual aid area emergency measures organization. It shall be known as The St. Brieux and District Fire Protection Association (hereafter referred to as "the Association").
2. The parties hereto agree that the Village of St. Brieux shall be, and is hereby designated as, the Administrative Headquarters of The St. Brieux and District Fire Protection Association. The Emergency Measures Co-ordinator for the Village of St. Brieux shall be the Co-ordinator for the St. Brieux and District Fire Protection Association and the Area Emergency Measures Organization Headquarters shall be this office in the Village of St. Brieux .
3. Each party to this Agreement shall compile a list of its own resources and manpower and furnish the Mutual Aid Area Co-ordinator with such list.
4. In this Agreement the Association is responsible for providing joint emergency planning program funding provided by the Government of Canada under the joint Emergency Planning Program.
5. The parties agree that the aforesaid Mutual Aid Area Emergency Measures Co-ordinator shall be charged with the responsibility of working under the direction of the Mutual Aid Area Emergency Measures Control Committee and related sub-committees authorized by the Control Committee with the objective of carrying out all reasonable preparatory steps designated to ensure, in the event of an emergency or disaster, that:
 - (a) Essential departments of municipal government and volunteer organizations are able to make the most effective use of their personnel and resources.
 - (b) Plans for the protection, survival and rehabilitation of the population be implemented without delay.
 - (c) The "Area" is prepared for the reception of evacuees from other municipalities, and the provision of mobile support to other areas.
6. The Rural Municipality of Flett's Springs No. 429 hereto shall contribute its share of the residual costs of the program on an annual basis of \$1,000.00 dollars per year for a three year term.

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Agreement, any of the parties to this agreement may withdraw from this agreement upon giving not less than one (1) year's written notice to withdraw, provided that the date of withdrawl specified in such notice shall be December 31st in any year. Such notice shall be served personally or by registered mail on The St. Brieux and District Fire Protection Association, which shall, in turn, advise in writing each of the member municipalities within the organization of the nitification of withdrawl by a party to this agreement.

AND WHEREAS the parties to this agreement intend to establish an organization of the type contemplated in Section 9 of the Civil Defence Act:

NOW THEREFORE THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:
